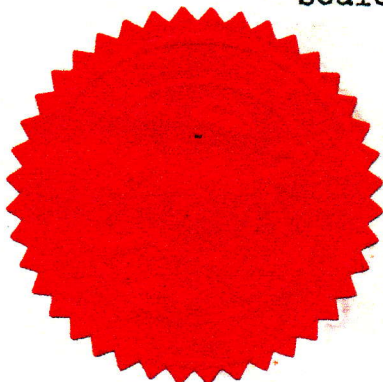
In the matter of the Charity known as the VILLAGE HALL, in the Parish of BARTON ST. DAVID, in the County of SOMERSET, comprised in a Conveyance dated the 23rd June, 1953; and
In the matter of the Charitable Trusts Acts, 1853 to 1939.

THE BOARD OF CHARITY COMMISSIONERS FOR ENGLAND AND WALES DO HEREBY ORDER that the land specified in the schedule hereto shall vest forthwith in The Official Trustee of Charity Lands for all the estate and interest therein belonging to or held in trust for the Charity.

SCHEDULE.

Land containing 0.243 acres or thereabouts situate in the Parish of Barton St. David in the County of Somerset and numbered 288 on the Ordnance Survey map (1930 Edition), together with the buildings thereon formerly known as the Barton St. David Old Church of England School, comprised in the above-mentioned Conveyance dated the 23rd June 1953 made between Philip Sewell Thomas and two others of the one part and the said Philip Sewell Thomas and another of the other part and recorded in the books of the Ministry of Education pursuant to the provisions of S.29(4) of the Settled Land Act, 1925, as applied by Article 3 of the Minister of Education (Transfer of Functions) Order, 1949, on the 13th July 1953.
